### **1.0 PURPOSE**

The Clery Act requires that the University have and disclose emergency response and evacuation procedures in response to a significant emergency or dangerous situation involving an immediate threat to the health or safety of students or employees occurring on the campus. To inform the University community of a significant emergency or dangerous situation involving an immediate threat to the health or safety of students or employees occurring on the campus the University will issue a Timely Warning to the University community. This Policy is intended to ensure that the University is sufficiently prepared for an emergency situation on campus. The University’s statement of policy along with other security-related policy statements is included in the University’s Annual Security Report.

### **2.0 SCOPE**

This Policy applies to all members of the University community.

### **3.0 POLICY**

The University Police Department will issue a crime alert in a timely manner for immediate, as well as on-going, threats to safety and to aid in the prevention of similar crimes. Specifically, these crimes will include situations that are reported to University Police that are considered serious or continuing threats to the University community. Timely Warnings will be communicated via one or more of the following: text message (Rave system), e-mail, posted notice, and/or media sources at the discretion of the Chief of the University Police Department. Missing students will be immediately investigated by a number of individuals in key positions with the University. Any time a student is suspected of being missing the MSSU Policy should be contacted at 417-626-2222. All members of the University community are responsible for and expected to keep their contact information up to date in the Rave system. Failure to update contact information in the Rave system could result in delays or failure to receive a Timely Warning.
