Advanced CSI Level IV

Buried Body/Subsurface Excavation Course MISSOURI SOUTHERN STATE UNIVERSITY

The Advanced CSI Level IV course recommends the student attended CSI levels I, II & III <u>but is not mandated.</u>

Skills learned in previous CSI courses will be used in Advanced CSI level IV.

Class will be limited to 15 people.

Day 1: Theory of Subsurface Excavation, supplies needed and methods for establishing location of a Burial site, such as:

- Foliage determination
- Probing
- Grid Establishment
- Datum point

Students will also observe and train on a pre-excavated outdoor site at MSSU.

Day 2: Students will travel to an (off-site) practical exercise location all day. Equipment will be provided for locating, excavation, evidence collection and removal of skeletal remains form a Burial Site.

Day 3: Finish up practical exercises at burial sites, preparation and Group PowerPoint.
