Seating will be limited to the first **15 officers**.

This course will give students the necessary training to receive a Type III permit through the Missouri Department of Health. This permit will allow the holder to operate the: DMT. Applicants must be 21 years of age, presently employed with Law Enforcement Agency.

During the course, Officers will be trained in the proper operations and functions of the breath instrument. They will receive training in DWI Detection and standardized Field Sobriety Testing. We will also discuss how different types of alcohol are produced and their effect on human body. Students will receive extensive training on the absorption and elimination of alcohol, DWI and relates statutes, implied consent, and case law reviews.
