SOCIAL WORK TRANSFER AND ARTICULATION AGREEMENT MISSOURI SOUTHERN STATE UNIVERSITY AND CROWDER COLLEGE

Purpose

This agreement is to facilitate the transfer of students between the Crowder College Associate of Arts in Social Work and the Missouri Southern State University Bachelor of Social Work.

Agreement

- The agreed upon two plus two programs apply to the Bachelor of Social Work.
- The agreed upon two plus two courses taken at Crowder College and Missouri Southern are identified in the addendum.
- The Bachelor of Social Work regulations for accreditation are met by courses in this agreement at Crowder College and Missouri Southern State University.
- MSSU's current national accreditation through the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) is supported by this agreement and the maintenance of competencies and course standards at Crowder College.
- Crowder College Social Work students with a 2.70 grade point average may apply in the usual timeline to the MSSU Social Work program.

Notice of Change or Cancellation

Either institution may change or cancel this agreement by notifying the other no less than one academic year before the intended date of change or cancellation.
