Within that email is a link to your Inclusive Access portal which allows you to opt-out and receive a refund during the first week of summer class. ### **Rental Textbook Returns**

Summer rental books are due by Monday July 29, 2024. If your book(s) is not returned or received with a postmark on or before the due date, the buyout price of the book will be charged to your student account and the book is yours to keep. If you choose to return the book within 25 days beyond the due date, the book buyout price will be refunded and a \$14 per hour, per book, extended rental fee will be assessed to your account.

### Repayment Notice for Federal Financial Aid

- Students who withdraw earlier than 60% of the semester will be subject to repayment of part or all of their aid, as determined by Federal Regulations. This includes official and unofficial withdrawals stemming from student's last date of attendance prior to the 60% of semester earned.
- Students will be notified in writing of any amount due. A hold will be placed on the student's account until repayment is made in full.
- Students must make repayment of their portion of financial aid within 45 days. Failure to make repayment within 45 days will result in:
  1. Referral to the U.S. Department of Education for collection.
  2. Ineligibility for federal financial aid from all colleges and universities until the repayment of aid and interest due is paid to the U.S. Department of Education.

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### Withdrawal Policy

Students who do not officially cancel their registration will be responsible for tuition and fees as indicated above. **NON-ATTENDANCE DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A WITHDRAWAL FROM CLASSES.** Please confirm your registration in LioNet (not Blackboard).

**WITHDRAWAL FROM A SINGLE CLASS:** Prior to the **first day of classes for the June summer session**, students may contact their advisor to be dropped from a single class or drop themselves through LioNet if they are eligible to self-enroll. Beginning the second day of the second week of the 8-week **June summer session**, students may drop a single course by completing the online [Single Course Withdrawal form](#) on the Office of the Registrar website or pick up a single course withdrawal form from the Office of the Registrar. The official date of withdrawal is the date the form is submitted online or RECEIVED in the Registrar's Office.

**WITHDRAWAL FROM ALL CLASSES:** Prior to the first day of the June summer session of classes, students can contact their advisor to withdraw from all their classes or withdraw from their classes through LioNet, if they are eligible to do so. Beginning the first day of the June summer session of classes, students wishing to withdraw from all their summer courses must see the financial aid counselor in the Financial Aid Office Federal financial aid recipients who withdraw from all classes will automatically be placed on Financial Aid Suspension.

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**LioNet** is Missouri Southern State University's web portal that provides personalized access to web services. In separate mailings students receive their LioNet ID number, or SID (begins with S and is followed by 8 numbers) and LioNet default PIN (6 alpha-numeric characters). Login with the LioNet ID, making certain to use a capital S and the number zero, not the letter o. Your password is the LioNet default PIN. Be sure to enter any letters of your PIN in upper-case. The PIN will also be used for registration.

All registered students have access to course information, group tools, campus life, work life, personal calendars, email, and more – anytime, anywhere. Check LioNet for your schedule, fees (including payment of fees), personal information, transcript, grades, campus announcements, statements and grade reports.

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**Degree Works** audit is an online degree evaluation guide available to all degree-seeking undergraduate and graduate students who have been admitted to MSSU since 2010. # DISTANCE LEARNING

Missouri Southern offers a large selection of online (Internet) programs and courses. For a complete listing of online programs visit the Department of Digital Learning's website: <https://www.mssu.edu/academics/distance-learning/>. Most online courses follow the same semester schedule as on-campus courses, but some do not. Be sure to carefully check the schedule for Delayed Start and other part-of-term courses.

Internet classes are not recommended for students with only dial-up or cellular Internet connections. Online students should not expect to complete all Internet course activities on a cellular phone or other mobile device. Students interested in completing Internet classes at MSSU must have access to a reliable laptop or desktop computer with high-speed (DSL, cable, fiber-optic) Internet access. A small number of courses require a Windows computer (PC). Be sure to pay close attention to course descriptions.

Internet courses are instructor-led, not self-paced, and students are expected to actively participate on a weekly basis, from the very first day of classes. Distance students run the risk of being dropped from any online course for lack of participation (submitting an assignment, posting to a discussion board, etc.) during the first seven days of the class. This drop could lead to the loss of Financial Aid.

Missouri Southern's primary learning management system (LMS) for distance course delivery is Blackboard™. MSSU's Blackboard™ can be found on the landing page of the "Students" section of the University website: <https://www.mssu.edu/student.php>. ## **Blackboard Course Availability:**

Blackboard sites for all courses will appear in Blackboard two-days prior to the official start date of classes. This extra time should be used by students to review important course documents in the "Course Home" area of each course. Students should not expect discussion board or email correspondence with professors to begin prior to the official start date of the course. Face to face courses also have Blackboard sites, but the extent to which they are used is entirely up to the instructor.

## **New Online Student Orientation:**

First-time distance students are automatically enrolled in the Department of Digital Learning's "Chalk Talk Blackboard Prep for Students" Blackboard Organization. Activities in this course are optional, providing Missouri Southern's new distance learners with information relevant to being a distance student, including the use of various Blackboard functions used by MSSU online instructors. The "Chalk Talk Blackboard Prep for Students" Blackboard Organization should automatically appear in new online students' Blackboard Organizations section shortly after registration and no sooner than two weeks prior to the semester start date. ## **Complete Proctored Exams Online:**

Students taking online classes requiring proctored tests, which are tests that must be taken in the physical presence of a testing monitor, will be provided the option of completing such exams online, see the course syllabus. To take advantage of this option, students will need a high-speed internet connection and computer with audio/video capabilities. Students also have the option of completing proctored exams at physical testing locations. There may be a charge associated with taking proctored exams at physical locations other than Missouri Southern's campus. ## **COURSE WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE FOR DISTANCE STUDENTS:**

**Withdrawal From a Single Class for Full-term Classes** Prior to the **first day of classes for the June summer session**, students may contact their advisor to be dropped from a single class or drop themselves through LioNet if they are eligible to self-enroll. Beginning the second day of the second week of the 8-week **June summer session**, students may drop a single course by completing the online [Single Course Withdrawal form](#). The official date of withdrawal is the date the form is submitted through the form portal.

**Withdrawal From all Classes:** Prior to the first day of the semester, students may contact their advisor to withdraw from their classes or they can withdraw from their

classes through LioNet, if eligible to do so. Beginning the first day of the semester distance learning students who wish to withdraw from all their classes must see reach out to the financial aid counselor in the Financial Aid Office at [finaid@mssu.edu](mailto:finaid@mssu.edu) to receive information and instructions on how to completely withdraw from their classes. After the deadline for full refund of charges, Federal financial aid recipients who withdraw from all classes will automatically be placed on Financial Aid Suspension.

## **TESTING PROCEDURES FOR DISTANCE COURSES:**

Professors of distance courses may ask students to utilize Testing Services to take proctored exams. Refer to the course syllabus or other course materials for complete proctored exam testing instructions for individual courses.

To schedule a proctored exam session on Missouri Southern's campus, contact Testing Services at 417-625-9577 or email [testingservices@mssu.edu](mailto:testingservices@mssu.edu). The testing services office is located in Webster Hall, Room 117.

Your instructor will explain the testing options that are allowed for your specific course. Every online student who is able to utilize Testing Services (on-campus or students who use an approved proctor, dual enrolled high school or home-schooled students), must email or call Testing Services to request an exam.

Students who live more than 30 miles from the MSSU campus (**off-campus students**), can test on campus or with an approved proctor.

Students needing a remote proctor should contact Testing Services for assistance. To request approval for a remote proctor please use Testing Services Proctor Agreement Form, linked below. The Testing Services Office must approve all proctors before tests are **emailed** to a proctor's location. Once the proctor is approved, the student may continue to utilize them. If the student lives in Springfield, St. Louis, Kansas City, Cassville, Lamar, Nevada, Neosho, and some parts of Arkansas, we may have proctors who have already been approved, please contact us for information. Local testing centers or libraries should always be utilized first. Testing Services can help with this.

Students are responsible for any remote proctor fees. If required, students may have to pay a charge for the Proctor's time and effort. Student must contact 417-625-9577 or [testingservices@mssu.edu](mailto:testingservices@mssu.edu), each time a student needs to take an exam. 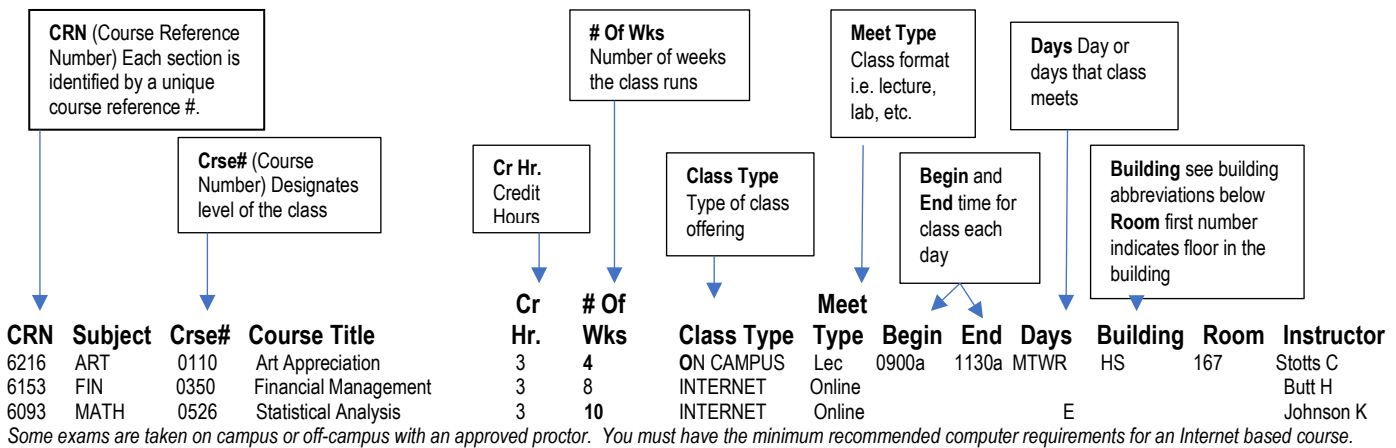
