Application Ready:

These tasks are only if you are ready to apply to the program and are currently an active MSSU student. **Do not begin these steps until the potential Pre-Applicant Checklist is completed.**

- □ All Core 42 courses are completed; the student must ensure that their Degree Works is up-todate and reflects all coursework completed.
- **The student has a 2.8 or better** cumulative college GPA
- □ The student has completed, with a C or better in 2 or fewer attempts, all pre-requisites or will complete by the end of the last full semester before the RN to BSN plan of study.
 - Students with remaining pre-nursing/general education requirements are advised to complete all requirements *no later than the semester before admission*. Courses must be completed with a C or better, and GPA must remain above 2.8 for the following pre-admission courses:
 - BIO 121 Anatomy and Physiology I (4 credit hours)
 - BIO 221 Anatomy and Physiology II (5 credit hours)
 - BIO; General and Medical Microbiology (5 credit hours)
 - Chem 121/122 Chemistry for Allied Health Sciences OR Chem 140/141 General Chemistry I (4-5 credit hours)
 - KINE 385 Nutrition for Human Development (3 credit hours)
 - Math 130 College Algebra (3 credit hours)
 - Statistics (3 credit hours) ** Applied Statistics OR Math 310 Elementary Statistics or GB 321 Business Statistics I OR SOC 405 Social Science Statistics
 - PSY 100 (3 credit hours)
 - ECON 101 or SOC 110 (3 credit hours)

- Accepted applicants must be graduates of a fully approved and/or nationally accredited nursing program (associate degree program or diploma program). Accepted national accreditation may be through the Accreditation Commission for Nursing Education (ACEN), the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE), or the National League of Nursing Commission for Nursing Education (CNEA).
- Please Missouri Southern State University Distance education programs are delivered out of the state of Missouri and may not be available to residents in all states.
- Accepted applicants will require completion and/or review by the Department of the Missouri Family Care Safety Registry and the United States Department of Health and Human Services exclusion list. Students who have been found guilty of Class A or B felonies or placed on the Missouri Family Care Safety Registry disqualification list will be ineligible to enter or continue in the Nursing Program.
